

# Sealed Units

# - Correct Waste Segregation



## **Yellow Lidded Sealed Unit**

**Non-soft** infectious or potentially infectious clinical waste contaminated with chemicals or pharmaceutical / medicinal wastes e.g. IV giving sets.



#### **Blue Lidded Sealed Unit**

**Non-hazardous** medicines, out of date stock, ward or patient returns (**NOT** cytostatic or cytotoxic).



### **Purple Lidded Sealed Unit**

**Non-sharps** cytotoxic / cytostatic waste, including IV giving sets and left over preparations.



#### **Red Lidded Sealed Unit**

**Anatomical waste** including recognisable body tissues, blood samples, placenta, limbs etc.



**Do not** use for the disposal of free liquids.



**Do not** use for the disposal of sharps.



Sealed units should **never** be filled with more than 10kg of glass.



Sealed units should be filled to a **maximum** of three-quarters full **OR** to the fill-line marked on the container **OR** to the maximum weight of 20kg, whichever is reached first.
